Editing Repeating Entries		
Entries originally created in the OracleCal “thick” client.	Repeating entries are linked and can be edited as a group.	Repeating entries are <i>not</i> linked and can <i>not</i> be edited as a group.
Entries originally created in the OCFO client.	Repeating entries are linked and can be edited as a group.	Repeating entries are linked and can be edited as a group.
Deleting Calendar Entries	The “thick” client will give you the option of deleting either an individual entry or all instances of a repeating entry using the Delete key.	<p>Deleting a meeting from the Outlook Connector does not remove a meeting. What it does is acknowledge that you have declined the meeting (when viewed in the “thick” client.)</p> <p>In order to remove it permanently, you must hold down the shift key when you are deleting the meeting in question.</p> <p>If you have already deleted meetings which still appear, you must remove them from the Deleted Items folder.</p>
